#### **Mission Thursdays Continues Through The Summer**

The Mission & Outreach Committee has decided to continue Mission Thursday through the summer. Many organizations take a "pause" through the summer so donations are down to both the Cherry Hill Food Pantry (CHFP) and Cathedral Kitchen (CK). Both these organizations really need our help



through the summer months to provide food to members of our community that deal with food insecurity on a daily basis.

The Mission & Outreach Committee wants to thank the congregation for their outstanding support of the CHFP and CK. Since the start of Mission Thursday during the early stages of the pandemic, we have donated over 26,000 sandwiches, almost 11,000 bottles of water, almost 900 bags of fruit and over 350 bags/boxes of snacks to CK. In addition, we have donated over 13,000 pounds of food and miscellaneous supplies to the CHFP. Through these donations, we are making a real difference in our community.

Boxed tissues, Hand sanitizers, 8 ½ x 11 White copier paper, Children's mask (sm- K-2, med- 3-5, lg- 6-8), Primary Journal Composition Book for grades K-2 Only, Lysol Cleaner (to wipe desk, door knobs, etc.) Sanitizer wipes, Lysol aerosol spray, Lysol spray cleaner, Individual supply boxes, Erasers, Whiteboard markers – all colors, Whiteboard Cleaner, Small dry erase boards/Erasers, K-5 Themed Book Bags (i.e., Batman, Mickey Mouse, Capt. America, LOL, Minnie Mouse, Frozen, etc.), Pencils/pens, Colored pencils (not crayons), Bottled Water (we are still not using the water fountain), Jugs of water, 6-7 oz. Dixie cups, Non-perishable healthy snacks (NO PEANUT BUTTER, 100% pure juice pouches, etc.), Sheet protectors, Stapler, Staplers, Desk tape dispensers, tape. **Collection bins will be out beginning next Sunday, July 31.**
