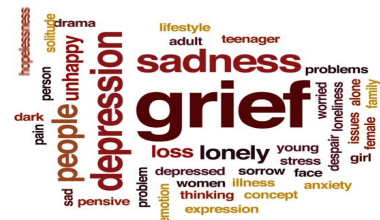

The Mission & Outreach Committee has decided to continue Mission Thursday through the summer. Both these organizations really need our help through the summer months to provide food to members of our community that deal with food insecurity on a daily basis.

In addition, we have donated over 13,000 pounds of food and miscellaneous supplies to the CHFP. Through these donations, we are making a real difference in our community.
