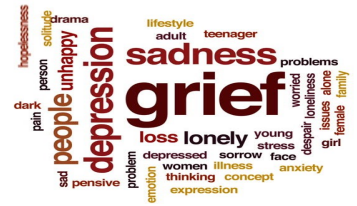
### **Holy Land Pilgrimage 2023**
