Per Capita is the \$39 per member annual fee which is sent to the Presbyterian Church (U.S.A.) for the ecclesiastical and administrative functions that support our connectional denomination. Children are not counted as members until the year after they are commissioned.

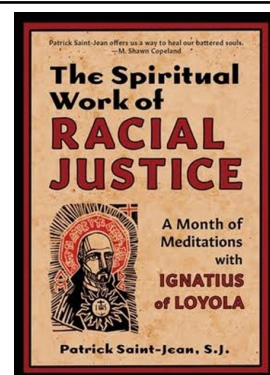
It's not too late to join Trinity's **Racial Equity Advocacy Project's** spring initiative.
