Trinity Has Gone SOLAR!

On June 25th, PSE&G installed our new meter, which tracks electricity in both directions. On June 26th we received the official letter of notification granting permission to operate the system. Later that day Absolutely Energized Power Systems (AEPS), came and turned the system on. We are now generating electricity with our solar panels. Any power that we don't use, is automatically sent to PSE&G, crediting our account for that electricity. We anticipate generating between a third and one half of the electricity used by the main building.
